In order for your customers to qualify for Benton REA's rebates they must be members of Benton REA and you must be an approved vendor through the Northwest Energy Efficiency Alliance (NEEA). To be approved and listed on NEEA's Installer Finder, at least one representative per company must attend a NW Ductless Heat Pump Project Installer Orientation. This training is available on-demand.
