

Income-Qualified Rebate Agreement

This agreement is between Benton REA and the parties listed below (member and contractor) in respect to enhanced incentives for the installation of certain energy efficiency measures. These rebates are available to members who meet the income qualifications set by the Sustainable Living Center.

In all cases, to be eligible for these incentives:

- o The member must own the home.
- o The homes must be served by Benton REA and be electrically heated.
- o Benton REA will inspect the home both pre- and post-installation.
- o In no case will the rebate exceed the cost of the installation.
- For HVAC, the contractor will submit sizing documentation and declare as to replacement/displacement.

The new storm windows must be on the BPA qualified products list and installed to BPA specifications by a company on the Benton REA window vendor/contractor list.		
	Other measures that, on a case by case basis, ma sealing and insulation of ducts, floors, walls or ceil	er measures that, on a case by case basis, may be considered include: whole home air ng and insulation of ducts, floors, walls or ceilings.
