Dear Contractor,

I am glad you are interested in Benton REA's insulation and air-sealing rebate program.

In order for your customers to qualify for Benton REA's rebates they must be members of Benton REA and you must be an approved contractor in Benton REA's program. To be approved, complete and return to me the contractor agreement form included with this document.

For many homes, rebates are available for weatherization projects. At the homeowner's discretion, the incentives may be paid to them or to you (the contractor). That designation is made on the Installation Form. When the incentives are designated to the contractor, that amount will appear as a credit against the cost of the job on your invoice to the homeowner. Benton REA Member Insulation Rebates

You may calculate the rebate by multiplying the square footage of the insulated space by the appropriate rebate amount according to this table. A pre- and post-inspection performed by a Benton REA representative is required to receive the rebate.

Insulation Location	Starting Insulation Level	Final Insulation Level	Rebate Amount Per Square Foot
Attic	≤ R7	≥ R38	\$2.00
Attic	R8-R11	≥ R38	\$0.75
Attic	R12-R19	≥ R38	\$0.30
Attic	R20-R30	≥ R38	\$0.09
Floors	≤ R11	R19	\$0.75
Floors	≤ R11	R25 or R30	\$0.90
Walls	R0	≥ R11	\$2.00

Contractor Air-Sealing Rebates

Incentives for whole-home air sealing are based on the reduction of the air volume moving in and out of the home – this is measured in cubic feet per minute (CFM) and determined by a blower door test conducted by a Benton REA representative before and after air-sealing. Benton REA will pay a rebate of **\$0.20/CFM**.

This document indicates the company listed below is interested in participating in the Benton REA weatherization program and intends to perform the program requirements on all projects that are submitted for weatherization rebates. A major aspect of those requirements is to ensure the work will meet BPA weatherization specifications (revised Oct.1, 2016).

Before work begins on the residence, the contractor will provide Benton REA, a completed <u>Weatherization Rebate Application</u>. Benton REA will inspect the home to confirm the anticipated incentive. Promptly after completing the job, the contractor is required to notify Benton REA so that a post installation inspection may be done. You are responsible for submitting a copy of the customer invoice and, if rebates are to be paid to the contractor, they will appear as a credit against the project cost on that invoice.
